Local Sushi Restaurant Sushiville Opens at Nyberg Woods

TUALATIN ,OR—Locally-owned carousel sushi restaurant, Sushiville, opened their third location on September 10 at the Nyberg Woods shopping center in Tualatin, Oregon.

After seven successful years on NW 23rd Avenue, owner Ryan Choy decided to expand his popular restaurant to the suburbs and opened at Nyberg Woods off I-5 in Tualatin. Along with business partner Hackmoo Kim and sushi chef Kiyoshi Adachi, Choy added the 3,400 square foot space to his restaurant portfolio.

Sushiville features 120 different menu items including a variety of “fusion sushi”, Japanese dishes, appetizers, and desserts. All of the dishes are fat-free, and cholesterol and MSG-free.

The sushi carousel that winds throughout the modern-design restaurant was built on-site and made from oak. Sushiville is one of the only Portland carousel sushi restaurants to have a wood carousel, which keeps the traveling sushi creations “the perfect temperature,” according to owner Ryan Choy. “The sushi is so fresh it moves,” joked Choy.

Choy looks forward to serving the Tualatin market and bringing a new restaurant option to the area. “We felt the Tualatin area was the perfect location for our third restaurant. We’ve experienced great response so far from shopping center employees and area residents, said Choy. “It’ll be a great year for us here at Sushiville.”

Nyberg Woods is a 250,000 square foot upscale retail center located at Interstate 5 and Nyberg Road in Tualatin, Oregon and features retailers and restaurants such as Best Buy, Golfsmith, Famous Footwear, Old Navy, Chipotle, Famous Dave’s Barbeque, Ulta, and more.
